Vice Chancellor's Research Associate – 1 post

National Law University, Delhi is calling for applications for the post of Vice Chancellor's Research Associate. The purpose behind this position is to provide research and writing opportunities to recent law graduates who are interested in careers in academia. This position is ideal for law graduates with 0-2 years Post-Qualification Experience (PQE) who are looking to gain research and writing experience before proceeding for higher studies, with the aim of joining academia subsequently.

Role of the Vice Chancellor's Research Associate: The Research Associate will assist the Vice Chancellor in a range of research and writing projects, as well as assist with other institutional activities as determined by the Vice Chancellor.

Qualifications: Applications are invited from interested candidates holding a degree in law. The candidate should have demonstrable research and writing skills of excellent quality. The position is ideal for persons who have a law degree and 0-2 years PQE. Those with higher law degrees are not prohibited from applying, but they should assess the suitability of this position for their own career trajectories.

Remuneration: Salary for the position shall be Rs.50,000 per month (consolidated). The position will be for a period of one year, extendable by another 6 months, based on mutual agreement.
