CALL FOR SUBMISSION OF FRESH BIDS FOR WEBSITE DESIGN

Date: 15th March 2016

Position: The Centre on the Death Penalty at National Law University, Delhi ("University") seeks to engage on a contractual basis, one **Website Design firm/company/individual** to re-design the existing website of the Centre.

About the Centre: The Centre on the Death Penalty was established in August 2014 to ensure competent legal representation for indigent prisoners sentenced to death; undertake new avenues of research on the administration of the death penalty; and also to open up new fronts and methods of discussion on the death penalty among various stakeholders and the public. The Centre was founded as a result of the Death Penalty Research Project, in which all of India's death row prisoners and their families were interviewed towards developing their socio-economic profile and mapping their experience with the criminal justice system. The Project, which began in May 2013, is now complete and its report is due to be published. The Centre seeks to broaden its engagement with the public on the death penalty over the next few years, for which the website is a crucial component.

A. REQUIREMENTS

- i. Graduate in graphic and website design.
- ii. Proficiency with HTML5/CSS, Javascript, PHP, Image/Graphics Manipulation etc.
- iii. Availability to complete the assignment by June 2016.
- iv. Prior experience of conceptualising and designing social science materials would be preferred.

B. Scope of the Work

The work entails the adaption of the existing resources at www.deathpenaltyindia.com alongside fresh additions. The target audience is extremely diverse given the nature of the work involved. Therefore, the design needs to be aesthetically pleasing and in keeping with the gravitas of the issue.

The website is expected to be a reliable source of data regarding the death penalty as in India. Thus presentation of data in accessible format is crucial. The design elements have to be in consonance with the requirements for a dynamic website. The website needs to incorporate infographics in the form of maps, timelines, etc. that will allow any user to navigate complex data easily. The nature of the content envisaged for the website is broadly along the lines of the present website, however the new website needs to be more streamlined, enabling efficient access to the Centre's resources while conveying the nature of work that it is involved in.

C. PROPOSALS AND THEIR EVALUATION

The University is aware that a precise costing might require further details but applicants are requested to indicate approximate figures based on the information provided in this call. In selecting applicants, the University will consider quality of previous work, relevant experience, along with the costing provided.

Application Process: Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- 1. Complete Financial Bid and the Technical Bid attached to this call
- 2. Cover Letter which must state "Attn: Director, Centre on the Death Penalty"
- 3. Resume
- 4. 2 samples of previous work (in hard copy, preferably as colour print outs)
- 5. Terms of service (or T&C, Discounts etc) if any as separate documents

The Centre is cognizant of the fact that the nature of work entailed allows for multiple approaches. Accordingly Applicants are to append additional details (if any) with the bid documents as mentioned before.

Post/Courier: Interested persons may send their work proposal, resume and at least two samples of previous work via post/courier. The postal address is "Registrar, National Law University, Delhi, Sector 14, Dwarka, New Delhi-110 078". The envelope must have super scribed on it, "**Centre on the Death Penalty - Application for Website Design"** and addressed to the Registrar, National Law University, Delhi.

Deadline: Applications must reach us no later than 20th April 2016.

- 1. The application process is exclusively by submission of hard copies through post/courier only.
- 2. The Centre works on behalf of all prisoners sentenced to death, regardless of the offence alleged to have been committed by them.
