

Centre for Comparative Studies in Personal laws (CPL) Workshop

Stitching Programme Introduction

Wednesday, Feb. 15, 2023



The full day workshop organised by the Centre for Comparative Studies in Personal Laws (CPL) at the National Law University, Delhi on Jan. 25, 2023 laid the foundation of these subsequent programmes. After that workshop, the women participants were divided into groups based on their interests in learning particular skills or vocations. For women interested to learn ‘stitching,’ the session was organized on Friday, 15th February, 2023 . This session, was conducted by Prof. (Dr.) Anupama Goel, Research Director (CPL) and Registrar(I/C) of NLU Delhi, Akash Singh, Member (CPL) along with Ms Deep Jajmann, Counsellor, NLU Delhi.

Before formally inducting the participants into the ‘women stitching programme (wsp),¹ the essential information like their levels of education, contact numbers, address etc. was collected by the students (Eshita, Manas, Vinayak and Dristant). Their commitment and passion to join these stitching classes, feasibility to go regularly, consent from the families etc. were discussed and gathered by talking to them in detail. Then they were apprised of the

nearby location of the Usha Silai Centre, #-547, Om Apartments, sector-14 Dwarka. As most of the women were unable to afford training fees, conveyance etc., it was agreed that the Centre/University will arrange for the same along with the accessories or materials required for the training, but on the condition that they all will have to be regular and sincere in their training.

After discussions, it was decided that the stitching programme will begin from 20th February, 2023 for thrice a week i.e. Monday, Wednesday and Friday, initially for three months. The Centre for Comparative Studies in Personal Laws looks forward to a fruitful journey with these women who are taking a step forward to take control of their lives and finances.
