



LL.M (PROFESSIONAL) PROGRAMME 2021-22



WHAT IS LL.M (PRO)?

LL.M (Pro) is a one-year executive diploma programme which aims at providing and enriching legal knowledge of professionals. It is meant for individuals from different walks of life who are desirous of gaining expertise in laws in their areas of work or interest. It will be taught through a mixed mode of contact classes and distance learning.

LL.M (Pro) is not a degree programme, and will not qualify a candidate for academic and other jobs that require a full-time LL.M or Master's degree as minimum qualification. It will also not qualify a candidate to appear for the UGC's National Eligibility test and other similar tests.

CURRICULUM

Candidates enrolled in the programme will have to successfully complete **eight** papers. There shall be **four core papers** (Semester I) and **four optional/specialization papers** (Semester II).

CORE PAPERS

1. Introduction to Law
2. Constitutional Law
3. Fundamentals of Law
4. Litigation Practicum

SPECIALIZATION PAPERS

Specialization papers will be offered in one or more groups of specializations. Each group of specialization/stream shall consist of **four papers**. The following specializations and papers are being offered in 2021-22:

(a) CRIMINAL LAW

Papers:

- (1) Substantive Criminal Law
- (2) Criminal Procedure
- (3) Criminology
- (4) Juvenile Justice

(b) BANKING & FINANCIAL STUDIES

Papers:

1. Commercial Contracts and Business Ethics
2. Banking and Finance
3. Insolvency and Bankruptcy
4. Securities and Investment Law

(c) INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW

Papers:

1. Introduction to Intellectual Property Law
2. Intellectual Property and Tech Innovation
3. Intellectual Property in the Creative and Digital Economy
4. Intellectual Property Licensing, Competition Law and Regulation

(d) COMMERCIAL LAWS

Papers:

1. Commercial Contracts and Business Ethics
2. Company Law and Practice
3. Competition Law
5. Securities and Investment Law

(e) ENVIRONMENTAL LAW

Papers:

1. Indian Environmental Law
2. Climate Change and Environmental Justice
3. Sustainable Development
4. International Environmental Law

CONTACT CLASSES & ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT

Contact classes will be conducted generally over a period of One week in each semester. Classes will be held for the minimum duration of 2-3 hours per course on each of the notified days.

Attendance in the contact classes is an important component of the programme and is strongly encouraged. Students are expected to attend all the contact classes. In no event shall a student absent himself/herself for more than 70% of the classes. If a student has less than the required attendance, he/she shall not be permitted to appear for the examination.

EXAMINATIONS & EVALUATION SCHEME

Examinations shall be conducted at the end of each semester i.e., in December and in June, on the dates notified. It shall be mandatory for every student to appear in the examination. If a student is absent for the examination, *for any reason* he/she shall be declared as “Failed.” Candidates who fail the examination shall appear for a “Repeat” Examination. If a student fails the “Repeat” Examination, he/she will have to re-register for the paper that he/she has failed in, after paying the requisite fees.
