It was resolved that the direction in the letter to cancel the tender of present contractor cannot be implemented to avoid the legal complications.</p> <p>The Executive Council further resolved that another direction "to immediately deploy the Safai Karamcharis who are protesting, by the University and pay them", is not sustainable in law and cannot be implemented, in view of various judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>The Executive Council was apprised that some students of the University are supporting the workers for their unreasonable demands and writing emails directly to the members of University Bodies, politicians, functionaries of the Govt., Electronics & Print Media and also to the activists without information & permission from the University Administration. All these activities on the part of students have adverse affect on the reputation of the University. The Executive Council took serious note of these activities which</p>

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		amounts to indiscipline on the part of the students. The Executive Council authorized the Vice-Chancellor to take appropriate action in the matter.

Mann	The Executive Council noted and approved the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in imposing a penalty of reduction of post from the post of Professor to the post of Associate Professor for a period of five years on Prof. J.S. 3.12	Action Taken Report on the report of Internal Complaint Committee dated 19.11.2019 for disciplinary action against the complainant, and her witness CW-2.	The Executive Council considered the report of Internal Complaint Committee dated 19.11.2019. It was resolved that in view of the recommendations of the Internal Complaint Committee, the complainant and her witness CW-2 be called upon to explain within ten days as to why disciplinary action be not taken against them.
