NOTICE

As you are aware, the fresh academic session is about to commence and the student body will be back on the campus shortly. In this context, it is imperative on the part of the administration to sensitize students about maintenance of discipline and observance of good conduct on the campus vis-à-vis new students. It may be noted that the students sometime indulge in the kind of behaviour that falls in the definition of Ragging as provided in 'UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and IPC.

You may please be informed that the definition of ragging has been expanded considerably in the recent past and it now includes a range of activities which puts others into inconvenience of various degrees.

In compliance to UGC regulations, it is mandatory and obligatory on the part of the University to display 'Zero' Tolerance to any act which may be construed as ragging as per the provisions of the UGC regulations. We have already constituted 'Anti Ragging Squad' in this regard.

The UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009' is hereby enclosed. We would like to draw your attention towards 'Annexure- I' (Part III- Sec 4) of the said regulation requiring **every student to furnish an affidavit** pertaining to compliance of the said regulation. It shall therefore be binding on all students to submit this affidavit immediately, as the University is bound by the said regulation and has to maintain such records. An affidavit of similar nature needs to **signed by the Parent/Guardian** (Annexure II – Part III – Sec 4). The Parent/Guardian will be intimated separately to submit the same.

Further a gist of important provisions dealing with ragging is also enclosed for your attention.

The Action to be taken by the Head of the Institution is provided in the Section 7 of the said regulations and the Administrative Action in the event of ragging is provided in the section 9.1

I am aware that the students of senior classes have always observed responsible behaviour and the University administration never had any occasion in the past to intervene and invoke the provisions of UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009.
