ABOUT THE ORGANIZERS

CENTRE FOR TRANSNATIONAL COMMERCIAL LAW, NLU DELHI

Centre for Transnational Commercial Law (CTCL) at NLU Delhi was established in 2016 with the aim of promoting an academic and policy interface for this emerging area of law. INSOLVENCY AND BANKRUPTCY BOARD OF INDIA

It has regulatory oversight over the Insolvency Professionals, Insolvency Professional Agencies, Insolvency Professional Entities and Information Utilities. IBBI writes and enforces rules for processes, namely, corporate insolvency resolution, corporate liquidation, individual insolvency resolution and individual bankruptcy under the Code and has recently been tasked to promote the development of and regulate, the working and practices of, insolvency professionals, insolvency professional agencies and information utilities and other institutions, in furtherance of the purposes of the Code.

INSOL INDIA

INSOL India is an independent leadership body representing professionals specialising in restructuring, insolvency, turnaround and related areas. Established in 1997, INSOL India has completed 23 years as thought leader of the insolvency industry. The organisation went through a major restructuring in June 2016 just after the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code came into being in May 2016. Its vision, mission and goals were re-chalked. With a new governing structure, and membership criteria redefined to widen the horizon of insolvency practice in the country, INSOL India is well grounded as a thought leader.
