The UGC on May 2016 has notified the University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher Education Institutions) Regulations 2015. 4.	Three Students (only if the enquiry involves students), one from undergraduate, one from masters and one from Ph.D. respectively. These students should be selected through a democratic process	Ms. Tia Majumdar (B.A.LL.B (Hons.), NLU Delhi Two students from Masters and Ph.D would be nominated through a democratic process in the event of an inquiry.
5.	One Member from NGO or Association, committed to the cause of women or a person familiar with the issues relating to sexual harassment	Ms. Devika Prasad Sr. Programme Officer CHRI, New Delhi
