Requirements for participate in the Exchange programme

Students seeking to come to NLU Delhi on a semester exchange must fulfil the following conditions:

- 1. Be enrolled with NLU Delhi's partner institution
- 2. Be officially nominated by their Home University
- 3. Have completed at least 2 semesters (one year) of law/allied studies at the partner institution
- 4. Have a GPA of 3 out of 7 (or equivalent)

Language of study

English (only)

Language requirements

Students who want to participate in Bachelor's (LL.B) or Master's courses (LL.M) will require a high working knowledge in English Language. In the event your current education is in English, a formal proof of fluency is not required. However, NLU Delhi reserves the right to request nominated students for such a proof at its discretion.

Application procedure

- 1. An e-mail from the home university confirming the name, year of study, exchange period and email address of the student nominated for the Exchange Programme at the National Law University Delhi has to be sent to: internationalrelations@nludelhi.ac.in.
- 2. Information/instructions on application process will be sent by e-mail to each selected student directly.
- 3. All required application documents have to be sent electronically.

Introduction meeting / Orientation Programme

An orientation meeting is organized for all incoming exchange students. Details will be communicated to nominated students via email.

A student mentor is assigned to every international exchange student at NLU Delhi. The mentor is a NLU Delhi fellow student who helps new exchange students in settling down and navigating the University and its systems.

Accommodation

Accommodation would be provided in University Students Halls of Residence, situated on the University Campus. This is **subject to availability**. Incoming exchange students must ascertain the availability of accommodation with International Relations Office before arrival. A nominal fee will be charged if accommodation is made available.

In the event of unavailability, students must make their own arrangements. University does not act as an intermediary.
