masters in law (LL.M), along with professional programs and certificate courses for non

lawyers. Through the All India Law Entrance Test, the university admits 123 students into the

B.A., LL.B (Hons.) course and 81 students into the LL.M course.

pedagogy and research. Over the last decade the university has established many specialised

research centres.

Responsibilities:

The Academic Fellow shall be expected to assist research work, in relevant areas in

consultation with the University. They shall also be expected to contribute other academic/

administrative pursuits in the University.

The work involved will require excellent research and writing skills in the area of Criminal

Law.

1. LL.M. or relevant Masters degree in Social Sciences from a recognised Indian or

foreign university with minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale

wherever grading system is followed), and a good academic record.

2. For those applying with a relevant Masters degree in Social Sciences/ Humanities/

Science and Technology/ Engineering there must be a clear and demonstrable track

record of interdisciplinary research involving the law.

- 4. Prior research experience including field work and data collection is desirable.

Requirements: Demonstrable research track record in any one of the subjects mentioned in this call. Interdisciplinary research will be considered as an advantage.
