Introduction meeting / Orientation Programme	--	<p>An orientation meeting is organized for all incoming exchange students. Details will be communicated to nominated students via email.</p> <p>A student mentor is assigned to every international exchange student at NLU Delhi. The mentor is a NLU Delhi fellow student who helps new exchange students in settling down and navigating the University and its systems.</p>
Accommodation	--	<p>Accommodation would be provided in University Students Halls of Residence, situated on the University Campus. This is subject to availability. Incoming exchange students must ascertain the availability of accommodation with International Relations Office before arrival. A nominal fee will be charged if accommodation is made available.</p> <p>In the event of unavailability, students must make their own arrangements. University does not act as an intermediary.</p>

Insurance	--	<p>It is compulsory to have a valid and adequate health/medical insurance in India for the entire duration of exchange.</p>
