Requirements for participation in the Exchange programme	 Students seeking to come to NLU Delhi on a semester exchange must fulfil the following conditions:  ✓ Be enrolled in a full-time programme with NLU Delhi's partner institution ✓ Be officially nominated by their Home University ✓ Have completed at least 2 semesters (one year) of law/allied studies at the partner institution ✓ Have a GPA of 3 out of 7 (or equivalent)
Language of study  Language requirements	 All courses at NLU Delhi are taught in English.  Students who want to participate in Bachelor's (LL.B) or Master's courses (LL.M) will require a high working knowledge in English Language.  Proof of English proficiency is required. If however student's current education is in English, a formal proof of fluency is not required. A certificate from the home institution of the student indicating the same would be adequate.  However, NLU Delhi reserves the right to request nominated students for such a proof or additional proofs at its discretion.
Number of places available per term	 2 students for one semester each (unless other arrangements are confirmed with the partner institution.)
Application procedure	 <ol> <li>An e-mail from the home university confirming the name, year of study, exchange period and email address of the student nominated for the Exchange Programme at the National Law University Delhi has to be sent to: international relations@nludelhi.ac.in.</li> <li>Application form and other relevant information/instructions will be sent by e-mail to each selected student directly after the nominations from the partner institution is received and processed. 	information will be communicated only on the student's university email id.  3. In addition to filling up the form, students would be required to upload copies of all required documents including a copy of their passport.

Courses offered	 Information is emailed to students after their application is processed. All course selections are done online and students are notified of their enrolments
	Students take between 12 & 17 credits per term (usually 4 courses per term). Classes typically run 3 - 5 hours per week.

Introduction meeting / Orientation Programme	 An orientation meeting is organized for all incoming exchange students. Details will be communicated to nominated students via email.  A student mentor is assigned to every international exchange student at NLU Delhi. The mentor is a NLU Delhi fellow student who helps new exchange students in settling down and navigating the University and its systems.
Accommodation	 Accommodation would be provided in University Students Halls of Residence, situated on the University Campus. This is <b>subject to availability</b> . Incoming exchange students must ascertain the availability of accommodation with International Relations Office before arrival. A nominal fee will be charged if accommodation is made available.  In the event of unavailability, students must make their own arrangements. University does not act as an intermediary.

Insurance	 It is compulsory to have a valid and adequate health/medical insurance in India for the entire duration of exchange.
