Institution of IPR Chair Scholarship from SPRIHA IPR Chair Funds

National Law University Delhi is pleased to announce the institution of two IPR Chair Scholarships—one each for its undergraduate programme and for its WIPO–NLUD–IPO Joint LL.M./Master’s Programme—to be awarded in accordance with the amended SPRIHA guidelines.

Scholarship Details

Two scholarships of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) each shall be awarded annually, as detailed below:

1. Undergraduate Programme (B.A. LL.B.)

The scholarship shall be awarded to the student who secures the highest marks in the compulsory Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) paper in the B.A. LL.B. programme.

2. Postgraduate Programme (Joint Masters/LL.M.)

The scholarship shall be awarded to the student who secures the highest marks in the paper titled “*General Principles of Intellectual Property Rights*” under the WIPO–NLUD–IPO Joint Master’s / LL.M. in Intellectual Property Law and Management Programme.

Eligibility & Conditions

- ✓ The student must secure a minimum of 60% marks in the relevant paper.
- ✓ The student must be the highest scorer in the relevant paper, in accordance with the criteria specified above.
- ✓ The student must present at least one original article on an IPR-related topic during the relevant academic year.
- ✓ The student must actively participate in the activities of and work under the supervision of the CIIPC–IPR Chair for a minimum period of 3 months during the relevant academic year.
- ✓ The student may be required to submit a final report for evaluation on the work undertaken under the supervision of the CIIPC-IPR Chair.
- ✓ Students scoring less than 60% in the final report shall be rendered ineligible.

- ✓ In case of discontinuation of studies without prior approval of the University, the entire scholarship amount shall be refunded.
- ✓ The University reserves the right to terminate the scholarship in cases of misconduct or ineligibility detected at any stage, with recovery of the awarded amount.

Award Process

- Upon declaration of examination results, for both the Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) programmes, the details of the highest scorer may be communicated from examination department to ipr.chair@nludelhi.ac.in

The following information may be provided:

- Upon receipt of the information, the CIIPC–IPR Chair may onboard the selected student and assign work and activities for a minimum period of 3 months.
 - Upon verification and fulfillment of all prescribed conditions, the CIIPC–IPR Chair shall communicate to the University the names of the students who have successfully fulfilled the eligibility requirements.
 - The scholarship amount of Rs. 50,000/- each (B.A. LL.B. and WIPO–NLUD–IPO Joint Master’s / LL.M. in Intellectual Property Law and Management Programme) shall be awarded to successful candidates from the IPR Chair funds earmarked for this purpose.
