### **Supervisor – Research and Training, Victim Advocacy Project**

- **Type of Employment** – Contractual; Full-Time; On-Site
- **Duration:** Three-year engagement, extendable subject to university approval.

#### **ABOUT THE 'VICTIM ADVOCACY PROJECT'**

The Victim Advocacy Project (VAP) is a justice-focused initiative aimed at strengthening victims' access to the criminal justice system through structured legal representation and advocacy. The project addresses long-standing gaps in legal assistance and victim participation by providing continuous, professional support from FIR to trial, appeal, and rehabilitation.

Over the next three years, VAP aims to support more than 450 victims of crime, build a trained cadre of Litigation Fellows and Paralegals, and generate evidence-based insights to inform legal reform. By integrating field practice with research, the project seeks to develop a scalable model of victim advocacy for replication across India.

#### **ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Updated knowledge of the new criminal codes and special legislations, complemented by a comprehensive understanding of victimological perspectives in Indian criminal jurisprudence.
- Proven experience in research relating to victim rights and victim-centred justice
- Strong legal research and academic acumen
- High proficiency in written and spoken English
- Proficiency in the use of MS Word and PowerPoint
- Proficient in developing and working with training modules for capacity-building programmes
- Strong management and coordination skills, including the ability to supervise fellowship candidates, support their training, and act as a liaison between the fellows and the University

#### **DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS**

- Previous work experience (2 years or more) in similar fields

- Experience planning capacity building programmes
- Proficiency in the use of MS Excel, AI tools, and graphic design tools;
- Proficiency in social media outreach

### **DELIVERABLES (Roles and Responsibilities)**

The Project Supervisor (Research and Training) is expected to lead and oversee the following functions:

- Design and curate training modules on relevant legislations in furtherance of the project's academic and coursework objectives
- Mentor Litigation Fellows and Paralegals through structured engagement with these modules, supporting their academic and practical development
- Coordinate between fellows and the University as well as act as a liaison between the litigation team, project leadership, and the University
- Collaborate with legal institutions and relevant platforms, including identifying and curating resource persons for project-related events.
- Work closely with the Documentation team to collect, collate, and analyse data from the litigation fellows.
- Ensure adherence to professional standards, timelines, and project objectives
