NOTIFICATION

Subject: Assistant Professor (Law) Recruitment Examination, 2026.

This is for the information of all concerned that pursuant to the advertisement dated 19.11.2025 for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor at National Law University Delhi, the University shall conduct the recruitment examination only for the discipline of Law at this stage.

Accordingly, the recruitment process for the disciplines of Sociology and Political Science shall not be conducted presently.

The written examination for the post of Assistant Professor (Law) is scheduled to be held on Sunday, 21st June 2026 at 11.00 am to 2.00 pm (reporting time 10.30 am) at National Law University Delhi, Sector – 14, Dwarka, New Delhi – 110 078 and shall comprise the following components:

The test shall comprise of:

1. Paper - I: 50 MCQs on Legal Research and Teaching Methodology carrying 1 mark each.
2. Paper - II: Subject-specific descriptive questions relating to the candidate's chosen specialisation (Four questions of 25 marks each).

The list of shortlisted candidates eligible to appear in the written examination has been published separately on the University website along with their respective Application Numbers.

List of available Specialisations for Paper - II: Constitutional Law, Legal Theory, Criminal Law, International Trade Law, Corporate Law, Intellectual Property Law, Cyber & Technology Law, Environmental Law, Civil Procedure Code, Law & Legal Research.

The following specialisations have been withdrawn due to highly inadequate number of applications: Personal Law, Clinical Legal Research, Alternative Dispute Resolution, Taxation, Banking, Insurance & Insolvency.

1. Minimum three times of the candidates against the total posts advertised will be called for interview as per the reservation category.
2. Candidates securing less than 55% marks in each Paper – I and Paper – II separately, will not be eligible for next stage of selection.
3. Candidates are advised to carefully verify their Registration Number and subject specialisation before appearing in the examination.
4. Shortlisted Candidates are hereby informed to verify and confirm their specialisation on the application portal at which they initially applied by 6th June, 2026. Candidates who fails to confirm their specialisation will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
5. Candidates who had earlier opted for specialisation no longer under consideration may revise their specialisation preferences in accordance with the instructions issued by the University.
6. Any further update shall be communicated through the portal.

8. No TA/DA shall be paid for attending this examination.

The syllabus shall broadly correspond to subjects ordinarily taught at undergraduate and postgraduate levels in Law. The examination shall assess analytical, conceptual and application-oriented understanding.
