CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The National Law University Delhi invites expressions of interest for the contractual position of one Research Assistant under the DPIIT IPR Chair established by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. This position is part of the Scheme for Pedagogy and Research in IPRs for Holistic Education and Academia (SPRIHA).

ABOUT THE IPR CHAIR: -

The Chair on IPR is instituted by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India with the vision to “facilitate intellectual property education and research”. The Chair on IPR was instituted by the DPIIT at NLU in October 2018. The overall objectives of the IPR Chair are laid out in the [Scheme for Pedagogy and Research in IPRs for Holistic Education and Academia \(SPRIHA\)](#).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- i) The selected candidates will receive a monthly remuneration as mentioned in the table given above. TDS @ 10% under section 194J of the Income Tax Act 1961 will be deducted on monthly remuneration as per NLU Delhi Regulations funded by the respective Programme.

- ii) The appointment will be for an initial period of one year, with the possibility of extension based on satisfactory performance and the availability of funds.
- iii) No additional benefits/perks will be provided.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE RESEARCH ASSISTANT:-

Under the aegis of DPIIT-IPR Chair, NLU Delhi, the Research Assistant shall perform the following:-

1. The selected Research Assistant will provide support to the IPR Chair in conducting its research and all allied activities.
2. As part of the assigned research, the Research Assistant is expected to engage in diverse research activities including field work, data collection, data analysis, report drafting, etc.
3. Research Assistant is also expected to supervise the work of the student researchers/ interns associated with the IPR Chair and/or assist principal investigators in conducting research.
4. Research Assistants are also expected to assist in other research and dissemination activities of the IPR Chair.
5. Participate in overall planning and development of research, training and extension of overall activities of the Chair. They shall perform any other duties including administrative work which are germane to the aims and objectives of the DPIIT-IPR Chair and related with CIIPC and conduct its activities jointly.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- a. Minimum Higher Educational Qualification (10 marks),
- b. Grades obtained (10 marks),
- c. Relevant experience, if any (20 marks),
- d. Writing Sample/Relevant Publications, if any (20 marks),
- e. Statement of Purpose (10 marks),
- f. Interview (30 marks).

The candidates invited for the interview shall be in a 1:5 ratio after screening the candidates for qualifying in a - e as above.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES:

- 1) Candidates must ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions as on the last date for receipt of applications. Eligibility will be determined based on qualifications and information submitted up to that date only. No additional documents will be considered thereafter.
- 2) If at any stage—before or after selection—it is found that a candidate does not meet eligibility criteria, has provided false/incorrect information, concealed facts, or submitted fake documents, their candidature/appointment will be cancelled and may lead to legal action.
- 3) Mere possession of the prescribed qualifications does not entitle a candidate to be called for an interview. Candidates will be shortlisted based on scrutiny of applications and other criteria decided by the University. The University's decision regarding eligibility, shortlisting, and selection shall be final and binding, and no correspondence will be entertained.
- 4) Applications that are incomplete, received after the last date, or not supported with the prescribed application fee and required self-attested documents/testimonials will be rejected.
- 5) Candidates currently in employment must submit their application through the proper channel.
- 6) The University reserves the right to: (i) Accept or reject any application; (ii) Withdraw the advertisement; (iii) Modify the selection process, or (iv) Withhold the post at any stage without assigning any reason.
- 7) Canvassing in any form will lead to disqualification.
- 8) The appointment:
 - Will be purely temporary and will not confer any right to regularization,
 - Will not carry benefits applicable to regular faculty,
 - Will be subject to verification of antecedents,
 - May be terminated at any time due to misconduct, unsatisfactory performance, or subsequent ineligibility.

- 9) The selected candidate must demonstrate advanced skills, relevant experience, research contributions, and measurable impact appropriate for a high-standard national-level higher education institution.
- 10) No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview or interaction.
- 11) The rules and regulations of National Law University Delhi shall be applicable to the selected candidate.
