- 3,000–5,000 words (excluding footnotes)
- Abstract should be less than 200 words.
- OSCOLA 4th edition should be followed for footnotes.
- Similarity index below 15%
- AI use is strictly prohibited.
- Must be original, unpublished work.
- The copyright of the manuscript shall vest with the UNESCO Chair for Clean Sports

- Use initial capitals for all words except prepositions/articles
- Headings: 1. First Order | 1.1 Second Order | 1.1.1 Third Order

- Co-authored: ₹500
